Dear Brethren!

I was very encouraged with Phil Wright's latest report from the last work day, and especially the building inspector's cooperation. I think our wonderful Lord has guided us this far, and He will lead us the rest of the way toward the completion of these structures, so that we will be able to have Youth Camp here in 2012.

Phil's assessment is that we need \$30,000 to get these building ready enough to get a temporary occupancy permit for the May/June 2012 camp season.

So, how do we get the \$30,000 ??

When I am challenged with seemingly insurmountable tasks, I usually break it down into smaller segments. Then the task does not seem to be so daunting.

Let's assume that there are approximately 100 giving units among the churches that are supporting the Camp Tishomingo endeavor. If each one of these giving units were to give \$50.00 per month for six months that would equate to \$30,000. It is understood that some families would give more, while some may have to give less because of their personal financial status. But, all together, putting our shoulders to the plough we can get it done, with the Lord's help and blessing.

The Lord has laid this on my heart. I have prayed over it since receiving Phil's letter, and I am suggesting this approach. I am also writing a check for this cause tonight, and hope the Lord will use it as "seed" money, and that He will multiply it like He did the loaves the fishes.

Will you please help? Many of you have already helped in the past. THANK YOU! (Please read I Chron. 29 about collecting funds for the construction of Solomon's Temple.) I intend to keep a monthly status of collected funds on the website. So, check back regularly for status updates.
