The 2011 summer camping season is drawing closer! I encourage you to continue to promote camp to your children, teens, and adults. We are looking forward to a good ministry with the campers, and trusting the Lord to challenge and encourage believing hearts, and to bring those who do not know Him to salvation. We have received a good number of staff applications, but have several openings; I am including a flyer stating our current needs; please post this or make its contents available in some way.

I also wish to inform you of the construction progress at our property. Much has been accomplished as several men from different churches have been going to the camp on a regular basis over the last couple of months (the weather limited work over the winter months). The county building inspector was on the site a couple of weeks ago; Phil Wright, our Director of Property, showed him the buildings and the progress that has been made. After that, the county granted occupancy to the metal building, which is a blessing! And it appears that they will extend the building permit on the multipurpose building; this would save us several thousand dollars, so please pray that it is granted.

In order to have camp on our own land, we need to have the kitchen and bathrooms completed; the rest of the building can be used as is. To complete that, it is estimated that we need \$30,000. Sounds like a lot of money, but it is within reach of our churches.

I am asking you to pass this word along to your church family through bulletin and/or pulpit announcements. Perhaps the church can designate some money toward this, or can encourage individual gifts or take special offerings for the camp.
